

Spin-Art On the Job Instructions



1. Before leaving for the job be sure to have all supplies.
2. Once you arrive at the job, find the closest outlet to where you will be working. You cannot use an extension cord with the unit. Please call Ace the Party Place for alternative power suggestions.
3. Test the unit to make sure you are getting power. If not, try pushing the reset button on the white power cord coming from the unit.
4. Test each spin tub. Before testing, make sure the card or Frisbee holders are tightened down to the motor shaft securely.
5. Place cards in card holder. Fill paint bottles and place in holes in top of unit.
6. Place card or Frisbee in holder and press on the pressure sensitive button. While holding down the button allow the customer to drip paint on to their card or Frisbee. When the painting is finished, release the button and remove the art work.
7. For better paint adhesion on frisbees, prepare surface by sanding lightly in a circular motion with 220 grit sandpaper.
8. Clean up - Pour out paint back into gallon bottles. Put away supplies. Wipe spin tubs with a wet cloth and allow to air dry.

Accessories included:

- Allen wrench (for adjusting the card holder)
- Smocks

You will need:

- Tempra Paint*
- 5"x 8" Index Cards*
- Warm water
- Towels or Cloth
- Table (optional, for drying artwork)
- Adult Supervisor

Suggested Rules:

- Form two lines
- Artist may pick up each color only once
- Artist must hold color in one hand and push button with the other.
- Adult Supervisor must watch that children do not reach into moving parts
